## Narrative

Initial work for task 1 and 2 have begun by contacting some of the data providers for San Joaquin River Dissolved Oxygen and determining their interest in utilizing a local database that will be developed for them under task 3. Currently development of an Access database for the City of Lodi's effluent plan is underway. Databases developed under last years grant will be used again this year and will not require further development. A contract to fund these efforts has yet to be ratified. In addition our scope of work indicates a start date of October 1, 2001 (next quarter).

Work continues in a limited context as it relates to other work being conducted by the data management team. In addition, preparations for receiving funding for the grant have been undertaken; additional staff are in the process of being hired and purchases orders for the software/hardware are almost complete (Tasks 4 &5). The database interface (DBI) for the San Joaquin River Dissolved Oxygen Study is in its final draft and can be accessed at: http://sarabande.water.ca.gov:8000/~bdtdb/sde8/calfedsjrdo\_new.html. This DBI will undergo further review by the San Joaquin River Dissolved Oxygen group and modified as needed. CALFED staff have reviewed and approved the new DBI. About 65% of last years data have been loaded.
